Part A Group Discussion

You will be given 10 minutes to prepare. The time allowed for the group discussion is 8 minutes (or 6 minutes for a group of 3 candidates). You may make notes on the notecard provided and refer to your notes during the discussion.

The biography below appeared in a film magazine.

Bruce Lee was born in San Francisco in November, 1940. His father was a famous Chinese opera singer, and the whole family moved to Hong Kong, where Bruce soon became a film star as a child. His first film was called 'The Birth of Mankind', his last film, which was incomplete at the time of his death in 1973, was called 'Game of Death'.

Bruce was a loner and was constantly getting himself into fights; with this in mind he looked towards *kung fu* as a way of disciplining himself. The famous Yip Man taught Bruce his basic skills, but it was not long before he became a master of it. Yip Man was regarded as one of the greatest authorities in *wing chun*, a branch of the Chinese martial arts. Bruce mastered this before progressing to his own style of *jeet kune do*.
